About the Reid R Sacco Memorial Foundation

In the last few months of his life, Reid consolidated all of his dreams into two: to beat his cancer and to move on to his freshman year at college. The Reid R. Sacco Memorial Foundation was established in May 2005, shortly after his death, to provide the base for an organization that would concentrate into one place all efforts to carry forward these dreams – no longer for Reid, but for others.

The Foundation created two funds to which all fund-raising proceeds are directed. The funds are administered by an umbrella non-profit organization, the Essex County Community Foundation (ECCF) in Danvers, Massachusetts. These two funds are The Reid R Sacco Memorial Scholarship Fund, and the Reid R Sacco Memorial Cancer Research Fund.

Through generous contributions collected in the first several months after Reid's death, we were able to achieve our initial targets for endowing the Scholarship Fund, and we will grant the first *Reid R Sacco Memorial Scholarship* award this month to a high school senior setting off for college this fall. We have since been focused on achieving our initial targets for the Cancer Research fund. Our initial fund-raising targets for this fund are admittedly ambitious – on the order of \$500,000. But this target is necessary if we are to have any chance of making a sustainable difference in the pursuit of breakthroughs against the cancers affecting adolescents and young adults. These cancers have proven to be especially challenging and deadly adversaries; over the last 25 years their survival rates have evaded any significant improvement. The proceeds from today's event will help push the Cancer Research fund much closer to its goals.

About Reid Sacco

In May 2003, tests confirmed that the tumor in Reid's leg was rhabdomyosarcoma, a relatively rare but dangerous cancer predominantly found in adolescents and young adults. He was a senior at Lynnfield High School and a top student, a talented musician, and a National swimmer. He had just been accepted to Columbia University and was preparing to embark on a degree in chemical engineering. Despite an aggressive battle that took him through months of intense chemotherapy and radiation, and through countless surgeries that eventually claimed a kidney, a lung, and one leg, the cancer took his life on April 16, 2005. Those who knew Reid remember not only his courage, perseverance, fight, and will-to-live but also his humor, intelligence, selflessness, character, compassion, easy laugh and contagious smile. Although the cancer extinguished his life and so many dreams around it, it could not extinguish his spirit. We carry on his spirit in our hearts and in our commitment to find a way to someday stop the cancers that crush the dreams of thousands of young adults and their families every year.
